

Orthodox Position

- "One substance, three persons."
- Council of Constantinople (381 A.D.)

(one *ousia* [substance] in three *hypostases* [persons])

Distinctly Christian

- "In the doctrine of the Trinity, we encounter one of the truly distinctive doctrines of Christianity."
- Milliard Erickson (Introducing Christian Doctrine, L. Arnold Hustad, ed. (Grand Rapids: Baker Books, 1992), 96.

Is the word "Trinity" found in the Bible?

• No, but the concept is.

Why does our understanding of the Trinity matter?

- It determines how you view Jesus *Creation, Prophet, or Christ.
- 2) To whom are we to worship? Father, Son, Holy Spirit, or the Triune God?
- 3) To whom are we to pray?

The Early Church & Religious Marketing

- 1) The Resurrection & Lordship of Christ
 - alienates everyone not willing to bow to Jesus alone as Lord

2) The Trinity - alienates the strict monotheists & polytheists alike

CULTS/RELIGIONS WHO DENY THE TRINITY

- <u>Jehovah's Witnesses</u> a created spirit, Michael the archangel, who became God's Son upon being baptized = wrong
- Mormons (Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints). Jesus and Lucifer (Satan) were brothers. Satan proposed a plan to force humanity to follow God. Jesus proposed loving people to get them to follow God. Satan's plan was rejected and Jesus' accepted. Now they do not get along. God has a body and innumerable "spirit wives." = wrong
- Muslims = "God is one"

Q# Question for Muslims: Can God do anything?

*God and lying

Then why can't God exist as a Tri-personal Being?

Very important!

*We must get our beliefs from Scripture first...even if we may not fully understand them = <u>Truth first, then</u> <u>illustrations.</u>

*We must <u>not</u> reject that which we may not

fully understand.

*We <u>must</u> fit our minds to Scripture, <u>not "bend"</u> <u>Scripture to fit our minds</u>


The more precisely the position is determined, the less precisely the momentum is known in this instant, and vice versa.

Richard Feynman:

"I can safely say that nobody understands quantum mechanics. ...do not keep saying to yourself, 'But how can it be like that?'...



Nobody knows how it can be like that."

- Quantum mechanics is still a marvelous and necessary tool for understanding the quantum world.
- = Although the Trinity may seem "nonintuitive" that does not mean that it isn't true.

Skeptics: Why didn't the Church take an official stance on the Trinity for its first two centuries?

- Council of Nicea (325 A.D.)
- *Connection between Nicea and Constantine's Edict of Milan (toleration of Christians).

I. GOD IS ONE

DEUTERONOMY 6:4-5 THE SHEMA

"Hear, O Israel! The Lord is our God, the Lord is one! 5 "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might.

I KINGS 8:60 - SOLOMON'S PRAYER

"so that all the peoples of the earth may know that the Lord is God; there is no one else."

ISAIAH 45:5A

"I AM THE LORD, AND
THERE IS NO OTHER;
BESIDES ME THERE IS
NO GOD."

I CORINTHIANS 8:4

"Therefore concerning the eating of things sacrificed to idols, we know that there is no such thing as an idol in the world, and that there is no God but one."

I TIMOTHY 2:5

"FOR THERE IS ONE GOD,
AND ONE MEDIATOR ALSO
BETWEEN GOD AND MEN,
THE MAN CHRIST JESUS."

JAMES 2:19

- "You believe that God is one. You do well; the demons also believe, and shudder."
- 1 Cor. 10:20 "I imply that what pagans sacrifice they offer to demons and not to God. I do not want you to be participants with demons." (ESV)
- *If even demons are monotheists... then how twisted is polytheism?
- = According to Paul, it is demonic.

II. Three distinct persons in the Godhead: The Father

Matthew 11:27

"All things have been handed over to Me by My Father; and no one knows the Son except the Father; nor does anyone know the Father except the Son, and anyone to whom the Son wills to reveal Him."

*Clear distinguishing between the Father and the Son

Matthew 26:39 - Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane

"And He went a little beyond them, and fell on His face and prayed, saying, "My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; yet not as I will, but as You will."

*Jesus is not praying to Himself

John 14:16-17

"I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever;

17that is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides with you and will be in you.

The Father is God

Psalm 89:26

"He will cry to Me, 'You are my Father, My God, and the rock of my salvation."

Isaiah 63:16b

"You, O Lord, are our Father, Our Redeemer from of old is Your name."



The Son: A distinct person

John 7:39

"But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive; for the Spirit was not yet given, because Jesus was not yet glorified."

*Son is distinct from the Holy Spirit



John 17:1-5 *Distinct from the Father

"Jesus spoke these things; and lifting up His eyes to heaven, He said, "Father, the hour has come; glorify Your Son, that the Son may glorify You, 2 even as You gave Him authority over all flesh, that to all whom You have given Him, He may give eternal life. 3 "This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent. 4 "I glorified You on the earth, having accomplished the work which You have given Me to do. 5 "Now, Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was."

Jesus is God

NT writers faced a difficult problem in affirming that Jesus is God WITHOUT saying that Jesus is the Father.

• ὁ θεός - The word for "God" in the New Testament, literally "The God"

 Κύριος - Greek word for "God" in the Greek Old Testament (The Septuagint)



Jesus is God

Romans 10:9,13

"that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved...

v.13 for "Whoever will call on the name of the Lord will be saved."

v.13 exact quotation from Joel 2:32 in the OT!



Jesus is God

- I Corinthians 12:3 "Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says, "Jesus is accursed"; and no one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit."
- I Corinthians 8:6 "yet for us there is but <u>one</u> <u>God</u>, the Father, from whom are all things and we exist for Him; and one <u>Lord</u>, Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we exist through Him."
- ὁ θεός and Κύριος are used in the same verse!

Jesus is God: Firstborn means "heir" not the "first creation" *Cults

Colossians 1:15-19; 2:9

"He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. 16 For by Him all things were created, both in the heavens and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things have been created through Him and for Him. 17 He is before all things, and in Him all things hold together. 18 He is also head of the body, the church; and He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, so that He Himself will come to have first place in everything. 19 For it was the Father's good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him,"

2:9 For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form, πλήρωμα = fullness

Jesus is God: Oneness of God

John 10:30 "The Father and I are one."

John Gill, "Not in person, for the Father must be a distinct person from the Son, and the Son a distinct person from the Father; and which is further manifest, from the use of the verb plural, "I and my Father", "we are one"; that is, in nature and essence, and perfections, particularly in power." (Gill's Exposition of the Entire Bible)

John 14:9b-10a "The one who has seen Me has seen the Father. How can you say, 'Show us the Father'? Don't you believe that I am in the Father an the Father is in Me?" (HCSB)



John 20:28 - Doubting Thomas ἀπεκρίθη Θωμᾶς καὶ εἶπεν αὐτῷ, Ὁ κύριός μου καὶ ὁ θεός μου.

Literally = 'The Lord of me and the God of me!'

John 20:28 "Thomas answered and said to Him, "My Lord and my God!"

THE HOLY SPIRIT IS GOD

- JOHN 14:26 "BUT THE HELPER, THE HOLY SPIRIT, WHOM THE FATHER WILL SEND IN MY NAME, HE WILL TEACH YOU ALL THINGS, AND BRING TO YOUR REMEMBRANCE ALL THAT I SAID TO YOU."
- JOHN 16:14 "HE WILL GLORIFY ME, FOR HE WILL TAKE OF MINE AND WILL DISCLOSE IT TO YOU."
- * "HE" IS MASCULINE = THE HS IS NOT AN "IT."

THE HOLY SPIRIT IS GOD

ACTS 5:3-4 ANANIAS & SAPPHIRA

"But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit and to keep back for yourself part of the proceeds of the land? 4 While it remained unsold, did it not remain your own? And after it was sold, was it not at your disposal? Why is it that you have contrived this deed in your heart? You have not lied to man but to God."

MATTHEW 3:16-17 - JESUS' BAPTISM

"After being baptized, Jesus came up immediately from the water; and behold, the heavens were opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending as a dove and lighting on Him, 17 and behold, a voice out of the heavens said, "This is My beloved Son, in whom I am well-pleased."

MATTHEW 28:19

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit,"



- ISAIAH 6:8 "WHOM SHALL I SEND [SINGULAR], AND WHO WILL GO FOR US [PLURAL]?"





- 1) GOD HIMSELF IS SPIRIT; THE SOCIAL AND PERSONAL DOMAIN IS, THEN, CLOSER TO GOD'S BASIC NATURE THAN IS THE REALM OF MATERIAL OBJECTS


