Alister McGrath, “The worst thing you can do in the event of a spiritual dry spell is to give up going to church, spending time with Christian friends and colleagues, or reading Scripture. These can keep you going when your prayer life seems to dry up. They are like roots, searching for precious moisture in a dry land. - Unbelief bars you from experiencing “The Promised Land” of the Christian life

5) Exchange unbelief for **faith** and experience the Christian life – 3:16-19
