Jesus on money & the heart:

- Don't waste your life on _____ stuff – 6:19
- Stuff can't guarantee security because it's subject to decay, depreciation, and deflation. (Proverbs 23:4-5; 1 Timothy 6:9-10; John 10:10)
- Jesus is anti-possession; not anti-possessions.

- Do invest your life into what _____ says matters most – 6:20
- Missions work among unreached people groups (Matthew 28:19-20), local church work in your community: financially supporting the preaching of the gospel (1 Cor. 9:14), assisting in the purchase of food and clothing for the needy (Matthew 25:35-40), ministry to widows and orphans (James 1:27).

- Your heart cannot be _____ from your money: the use of your money reveals your heart – 6:21

Application: How do I make good investments?

- 1) Concede that everything you “own” is on loan from God.
- 2) Commit to biblical giving: beginning to tithe and give offerings to special ministries not out of a sense of guilt or legalism but out of love for Christ...even though such giving may be very scary.

- Don't waste your life on **accumulating** stuff – 6:19
 - Stuff can't guarantee security because it's subject to decay, depreciation, and deflation. (Proverbs 23:4-5; 1 Timothy 6:9-10; John 10:10)
 - Jesus is anti-possession owning you; not anti-possession.

- Do invest your life into what **Jesus** says matters most – 6:20
 - Missions work among unreached people groups (Matthew 28:19-20), local church work in your community: financially supporting the preaching of the gospel (1 Cor. 9:14), assisting in the purchase of food and clothing for the needy (Matthew 25:35-40), ministry to widows and orphans (James 1:27).

- Your heart cannot be **separated** from your money: the use of your money reveals your heart – 6:21

Application: How do I make good investments?
